

3. MOVIE AGAINST MOVIE: A MATCH BETWEEN MAAS AND HARTKE

The end of the year shall be remembered as the competition between two extraordinary movies: the horror film by Dick Maas "Sint" (in which our St Nicholas has been turned into a cruel middle age Bishop who frightens and kills





without mercy), and the epic historical movie by Gerald Hartke: "St Nicholas of Myra. The story of Saint Nicholas".

About Dick Maas' movie I already spoke in my first letter (as artistically wonderful, - it is enough to look at the movie poster to notice how much impressive it is - historically false, morally deserving blame, because children have the right to grow according to their age without terrible shocks).

Completely different is Hartke's movie. Keeping into account the universal knowledge of Santa and the human feelings (love and generosity) that his figure inspires, the Writer/Director Gerald Hartke has gone to the roots of Santa Claus discovering the IVth century Bishop of Myra (main actor Matthew Mesler, producers Christopher Santucci and Paul Mergenhagen, music by Seth Stachowski). From the point of view of history the movie could be criticizable, because it accepts the tradition of this second Millennium which included into the life of St Nicholas many episodes taken from the life of another Nicholas (who lived 200 years after Nicholas of Myra). However, this shortcoming does not distort truth (as Maas' movie does), because it gives a very faithful historical context (the

emperors Diocletian, Licinius, and Constantine the Great, as well as, Arius, Eusebius and so on). After history, myth and legend continues the message of the great Bishop of Myra through the children beloved Santa.

The movie has been seen by our friend James Rosenthal who spoke with the Director and the actors.

As he did, we too wish to it a great success.

I have seen the movie and you are right in saying that Dick Maas really is a master of suspense in creating this kind of films in a typically Dutch way (I don't think this film with typical Dutch scenes and humor in it will conquer the filmworld!), but to take Saint Nicholas, the icon of doing good, as a subject for this kind of movies goes way beyond the standards of morally good.



Although I own copies of the Gustav Anrich book, your news about the book being on-line is very welcome to everyone who is interested in and able to read the Greek sources. I will spread the news! To finish off I must say that I often come to Italy for excursion purposes with my pupils and also visit your country every year during the summer holidays with my family, but I regret that it is always limited to the north (to Napoli). I hope that in the future there will be some oppurtunity to visit the town of Bari, the relics of our Saint, and of course to meet you.

About the film "Sint": many people (100.000) have seen the film. It has a golden state for it. But they say, it is a very cruel film. As long as children do not see it, nor the posters, it does less harm as I feared on forehand.

I also heard that in the United States they make horror films about father Christmas. I did not know that. Still there are protests but they are now less because Saint Nicolas has arrived this saturday. (I was one of the 658 Black Petes in the procession). Everyday there is the "Sinterklaasjournaal" (Sinterklaas news) on the Dutch

television with all kind of news on Sinterklaas for the small children.
